Product Envelope

Instructions:

- 1. Cut two pieces of construction paper 9" x 6". Tape the two sides and the bottom together to create an envelope.
- 2. Cut one piece of drawing paper 8 ½" x 5 ½".
- 3. Glue the drawing paper to the front of the envelope.
- 4. Illustrate the front of the envelope with the title "Telegraph" and a picture.
- 5. Cut one piece of construction paper 11" x 5 ½". Write a paragraph about the telegraph based on the information from Communication From East to West on the front of the paper.
- 6. Make a display on the back of the 11" x 5 ½" paper with vocabulary, photographs, drawings, illustrations, quotes, or information from the documents about the telegraph.
- 7. Slide the 11" x 51/2" construction paper into the envelope.
